Maggie's Highlands (designed by David Page and Brian Park of Page\Park Architects, landscaping by Charles Jencks), in the grounds of the Raigmore Hospital, Inverness, opened in June 2005.

Maggie's Fife (designed by Dame Zaha Hadid of Zaha Hadid Architects), opened in November 2006.

Maggie's West London (designed by Lord Richard Rogers of Rogers Stirk Harbour + Partners, landscaping by Dan Pearson), in the grounds of Charing Cross Hospital, West London, opened in April 2008.

Maggie's Cheltenham (designed by Sir Richard MacCormac of MJP Architects, landscaping by Dr Christine Face), next to Cheltenham General Hospital, Cheltenham, opened in September 2010.

Maggie's Glasgow (designed by Rem Koolhaas of OMA, landscaping by Lily Jencks), in the grounds of Gartnavel General Hospital, Glasgow, opened in October 2011.

Maggie's Nottingham (designed by Piers Gough of CZWG Architects, landscaping by Envert Studio), in the grounds of Nottingham City Hospital, Nottingham, opened in November 2011.

Maggie's Swansea (designed by Kisho Kurokawa Architects with Garber & James, landscaping by Kim Wilkie), in the grounds of Singleton Hospital, Swansea opened in December 2011.

Maggie's Cambridge currently an interim Centre, next to Addenbrooke's Hospital, Cambridge, opened in October 2012.

Maggie's Newcastle (designed by Ted Cullinan of Cullinan Studio Architects, landscaping by Sarah Price), in the grounds of the Freeman Hospital, Newcastle upon Tyne, opened in May 2013.

Maggie's Aberdeen at the Elizabeth Montgomerie Building (designed by Snøhetta), in the grounds of the Aberdeen Royal Infirmary Hospital, Aberdeen, opened in September 2013.

Maggie's Merseyside at The Clatterbridge (designed by Carmody Groarke), in the grounds of The Clatterbridge Cancer Centre, Wirral, opened in June 2014.

Maggie's Lanarkshire at the Elizabeth Montgomerie Building (designed by Neil Gillespie of Reiach and Hall Architects, landscaping by rankinfraser), in the grounds of Monklands Hospital, Airdrie, opened in September 2014.

How many visits did we see in 2016?

In total, our Centres received almost 220,000 visits from people with cancer and their family and friends, an increase of 10% from 2015 (200,000 visits).

How much fundraised income did we achieve in 2016?

We raised a total of £19.5 million in 2016, £7.5 million in capital and £12 million in revenue income.

The revenue income has enabled us to continue the running of all of our Centres:

It costs around **£2,400** to keep a Maggie's Centre open for a day

It costs around **£12,000** to keep a Maggie's Centre open for a week

It costs around **£590,000** to keep a Maggie's Centre open for a year
